

Regulatory Changes for Labeling in Brazil

ANATEL more strictly enforcing labeling guidelines for small products

We would like to warn all customers that the Brazilian Regulator, ANATEL, is now more strictly enforcing the labeling guidelines for small products.

ANATEL Resolution 242, which contains the labeling guidelines, remains unchanged.

Until now, ANATEL had accepted placement of the ANATEL label (and interference/SAR mandatory statements in Portuguese) in the User Manual for various size products. A Labeling Declaration was used to seek permission for this from the Regulator.

At this time, labeling declarations are being rejected, even for products of approximately 5cm dimensions and less, if the ANATEL members believe that labeling of the product is possible.

The immediate impact is to new Approval applications, however we are aware of increasing strictness at import too, and suggest all customers to take steps towards this new methodology.

Products incapable of displaying the minimum labeling content may still be allowed to label the User Manual, via Label Declaration.
